School Advisory Council (SAC)

The Lea School Advisory Council (SAC) met last Wednesday, January 8th in the Lea Library. We discussed upcoming school events, our ongoing facilities issues and advocacy strategies, and discussed a plan for a February meeting around supporting our middle schoolers with the community. The SAC also completed a brainstorming activity to assess and address needs as part of the Winter Title I Family/Parent Input meeting, where Lea SAC members and families were asked to provide ideas for how to spend federal Title I resources, how we can improve programming at Lea, and how to better support family and community engagement at Lea. Some ideas included: more supports and resources for math instruction, climate, restorative practices, special education, and English language learners; more opportunities for recess across grade levels; additional common planning time for teachers; and considering additional administrative support for the Leadership Team. The SAC also proposed hosting a community meeting in February around youth, local businesses, and our Lea students with the District's Chief of School Safety, and we will let everyone know if we are able to organize such a meeting. Finally, we hope that families consider joining us at our next SAC Meeting on February 12th from 4:30-6:00 pm in the Lea Library. All are welcome!
